

This permit authorizes you to park in white or alternating red and white stall line spaces ONLY. Place your permit on your dashboard (this side up) and make sure it is clearly visible at all times while on campus.

If you choose to park in a metered space or the campus visitor lot, you are responsible for the accompanying fees. If you have the appropriate state-issued accessible plate or placard, this permit also provides for parking in an accessible space. The permit does not allow parking in a reserved space or other restricted area. Improper parking may result in a parking citation. See reverse side for more details on parking locations and bus routes/schedules.
